



Dry Erase Wallcovering VS Dry Erase Paint

GUARANTEED FINISHED APPEARANCE

Dry erase wallcovering is completely finished and carefully inspected in a manufacturing facility before shipping to a project. Paint relies on field applicator, who may be limited by job conditions, to determine its finished appearance and result.

PROVEN INSTALLATIONS

Dry erase wallcovering has been successfully tested thru many installations over the past 20 years. Dry erase paint is a new product.

NO ODOR

There is virtually no odor associated with dry erase wallcovering. Paint products may need to be installed in "off hours" or on the weekends, to keep the product away from others in an occupied building space.

SIMPLE INSTALLATION

Dry erase wallcovering is a simple and convenient installation, using clay based wallcovering adhesive. Paint systems on the market begin to cure/dry immediately when mixed. So, they must be completely used with a given time frame. Also, once applied paint may be difficult to touch up.

DURABILITY

The writing surface of dry erase wallcovering is a solid, "mill manufactured film" that is evenly applied across the entire surface of the product. It is more durable and consistent than a liquid coating that is painted onto a wall surface.

EASE OF SHIPPING AND STORAGE

Dry erase paint can be damaged in shipping or storage, creating a messy spill that requires special clean-up.

SMOOTH / "EASY TO ERASE" WRITING SURFACE

Dry erase wallcovering has a very smooth finished surface. Paint will not hide or cover up any surface imperfections of the wall.
